The \$10,000 Edna Award honors an outstanding young woman who has made significant contribution to social justice and whose leadership is fueling social change. The Award is named after Edna Berger, the first woman organizer of The Newspaper Guild and a longtime activist for social justice.

We welcome nominations of young women, age 35 and younger, from labor unions, women's groups, workers' rights organizations, immigrant rights groups, and any other area of social justice. Women cannot nominate themselves. Nominations must be made online at: http://bergermarks.org/awardedna/edna_nominationform.php. Deadline for nominations is 11:59 pm EST on July 24th.

An independent panel of union, civic, and activist leaders will judge the nominees and make the final selections. Winner(s) will be announced in fall 2015 and honored at a reception on November 12, 2015.
